What you can expect to work on:

The Cashier is responsible for cashiering, handling customers, performing basic cash office functions, and providing every customer with an exceptional shopping experience. The Cashier is the “face” of the ReStore and should act and work in a manner that is consistent with South County Habitat for Humanity’s core values.

Habitat’s mission... and how you fit into it:

South County Habitat for Humanity (SCHH) brings people together to build homes, community, and hope.

Your role is to engage with customers in a positive manner. The sales you make will keep these materials out of the landfill, provide affordable shopping for our local community, and raise funds that will go back to Habitat for Humanity’s home building mission.

Position Duties Include:

- Provide an excellent customer service experience and greet every customer in a helpful, courteous manner
- Check out customers and manage sales and holds
- Assure that the cashier stand is clean and orderly
- Answer the sales phone line
- Perform other tasks as assigned

Skills and Requirements:

- Must demonstrate strong customer service skills
- Must have excellent communication skills
- Must have a high degree of integrity and honesty
- Must be detail oriented and thorough
- Must be willing to learn or be comfortable working with the cash register

Time Commitment:

This position requires a commitment of one 4-hour shift per week, on the same day/time. A minimum of six month commitment is also preferred after training.
